12th International Workshop on Anthocyanins & Betalains

Reglamento de los Premios ReadyToPub



The Organizing Committee of the 12th International Workshop on Anthocyanins & Betalains (IWA&B26), which will take place on July 15–17, 2026, in Salamanca, Spain, will be running a competition to award the best student communications. The awards will be presented by the Organizing Committee and will be offered by ReadyToPub - Author Services Provider.

1. Recipients and Participation

The competition is **exclusively** aimed at undergraduate, master's, or doctoral students whose work has been accepted for oral or poster presentation. Participants are expected to adhere to the rules set forth by the IWA&B26 Organizing Committee.

2. Award Details

The ReadyToPub Awards provide students with credits to support the development of their theses and dissertations, as well as access to specialized services for enhancing scientific articles intended for publication in international journals.

The awards will be announced during the closing ceremony of the IWA&B26.

The following award categories will be presented:

1. One award for the best oral communication: **€500**
2. One award for the best poster: **€300**

The prize money (credit) can be used for any of the services illustrated on the following page.



Winners will receive instructions on how to use the award and contract our services on ReadyToPub’s online platform (readytopub.com).

Winners will have until August 31, 2027, to use the credit provided. The entire process of managing the credit will be the sole responsibility of ReadyToPub. The credit provided cannot be converted into cash.

3. The Jury

The jury for the competitions will be appointed by the IWA&B26 Organizing Committee and will consist of at least two evaluators.

The evaluation of the oral and poster communications will be conducted by the jury members using an evaluation grid that reflects the criteria outlined in this regulation. The final score for each communication will be determined by averaging the total scores from all the evaluators. The communications with the highest final evaluations will win the ReadyToPub Awards in each category (poster and oral communications).

In the event of a tie between two or more communications, the tiebreaker will be the highest average score in the first evaluation parameter (Scientific Innovation). Should the tie remain, subsequent parameters will be considered in sequence until a winner emerges. If a tie remains, the jury will determine the winner by roll-call vote.

4. Evaluation Parameters

The evaluation is based on the total points obtained (0-100) across the following criteria:

1. **Scientific Innovation** - up to 30 points.
2. **Applicability of Results** - up to 25 points).
3. **Clarity of Presentation** - up to 20 points.
4. **Design and General Appearance** - up to 15 points.
5. **Potential for Publication** in an international journal - up to 10 points).

5. Exclusions

Proposals submitted by non-students will not be eligible for the competition.

An individual cannot win in both categories (oral and poster communication).

6. Missing cases

The Organizing Committee of the IWA&B26 and ReadyToPub - Author Services Provider will decide on any case in which this regulation does not apply.
